

The **Garden of Reflection 9-11 Memorial** in Bucks County, PA was created to remember and honor the loved ones and all 2,973 killed on September 11, 2001. **Princeton's Sept. 11 Memorial Garden**, dedicated in 2003, features a bronze bell - titled "Remembrance" - created by former visual arts professor Toshiko Takaezu, and 13 stars placed in memory of the 13 alumni who died in the 9/11 attacks. **Princeton Battlefield State Park** interprets the scene of George Washington's 1777 victory. The **Thomas Clarke House**, built in 1772, which witnessed the fierce fighting. **Bucleuch Mansion** was built circa 1739 by a wealthy Englishman, Anthony White, upon his marriage to Elizabeth Morris, daughter of Lewis Morris, royal governor of New York and New Jersey. This Mansion is a fine 18th century two-and-a-half story house, with a grand entry hall.


