Christmas at Glencairn & Glen Foerd

Tuesday, December 10

Christmas has been celebrated at Glencairn since Raymond and Mildred Pitcairn moved into their new home in 1939. Today Glencairn Museum located in Bucks County, PA continues this tradition, a Christmas in the Castle, and its collection features outstanding examples of Nativity art, including paintings, illuminated manuscripts, sculptures, and stained-glass windows, many dating to the medieval period. World Nativities exhibition presents dozens of three-dimensional Nativity scenes collected from around the globe. Glen Foerd is the last surviving riverfront estate in the City of Philadelphia, and was built circa 1850 by Charles Macalester, founder of Torresdale and financial adviser to eight U.S. Presidents. In 1893 the estate was acquired by Robert H. Foerderer, a U.S. Congressman. 


